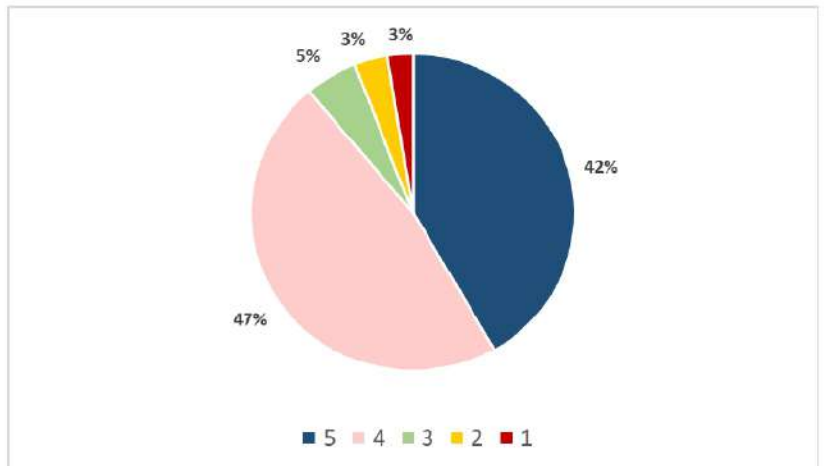

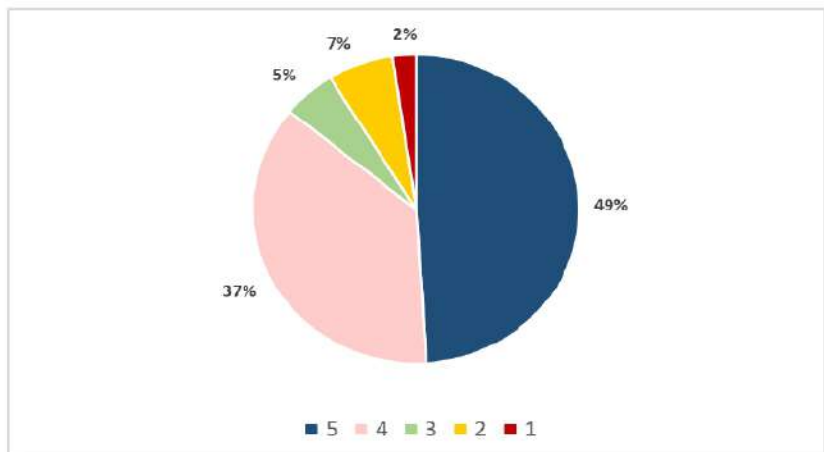
Question 1: Do you agree that the curriculum has sufficient balance between theoretical and practical knowledge?

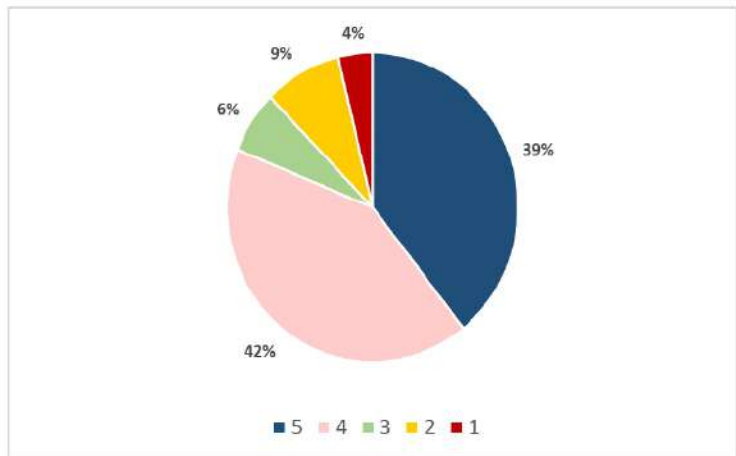
Question 2: Do you agree that the Curriculum provides adequate knowledge of the fundamental concepts?

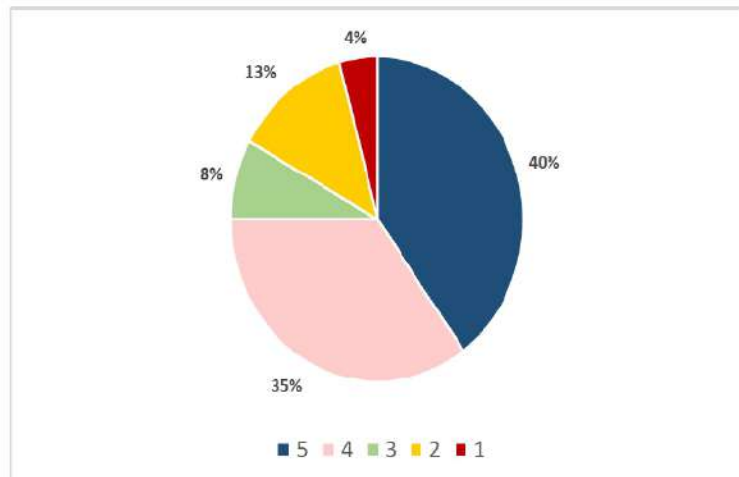
Question 5: How satisfied are you with the Teaching methodology and tools adopted by teachers for effective learning?

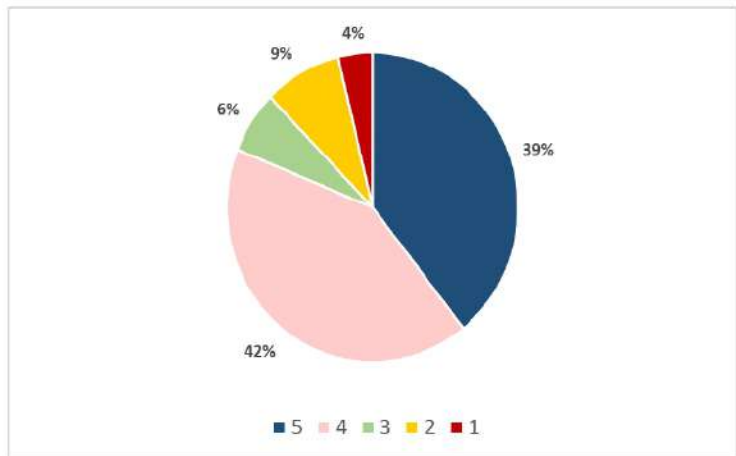
Question 6: Do you find the classroom properly equipped to provide a good atmosphere of learning along with necessary ICT tools?

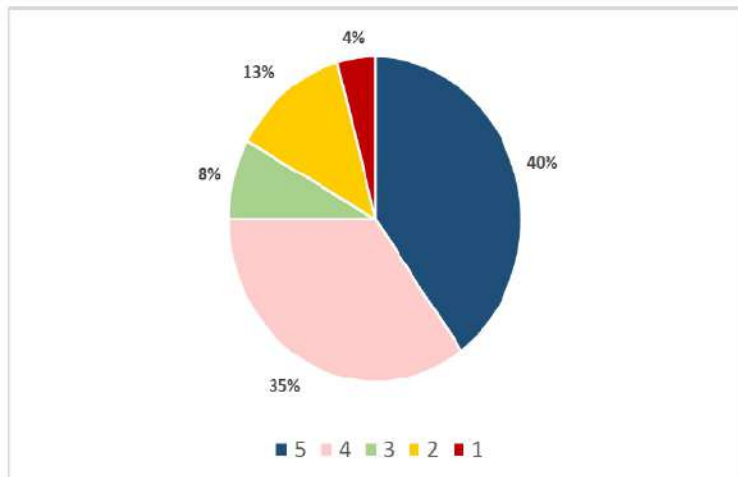
Question 5: How satisfied are you with the Teaching methodology and tools adopted by teachers for effective learning?

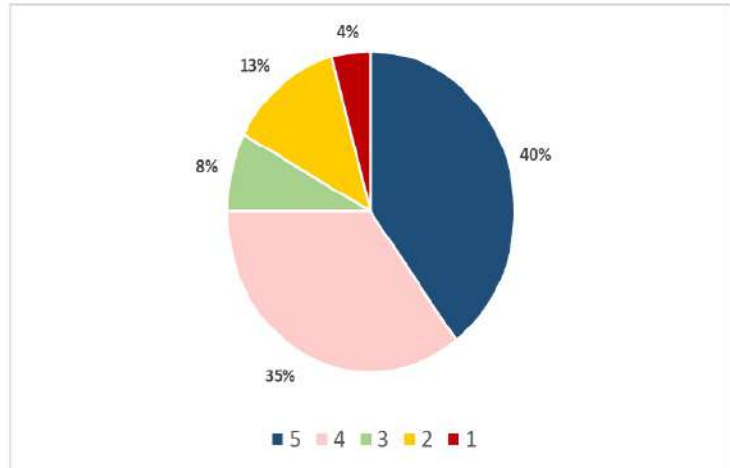
Question 6: Do you find the classroom properly equipped to provide a good atmosphere of learning along with necessary ICT tools?

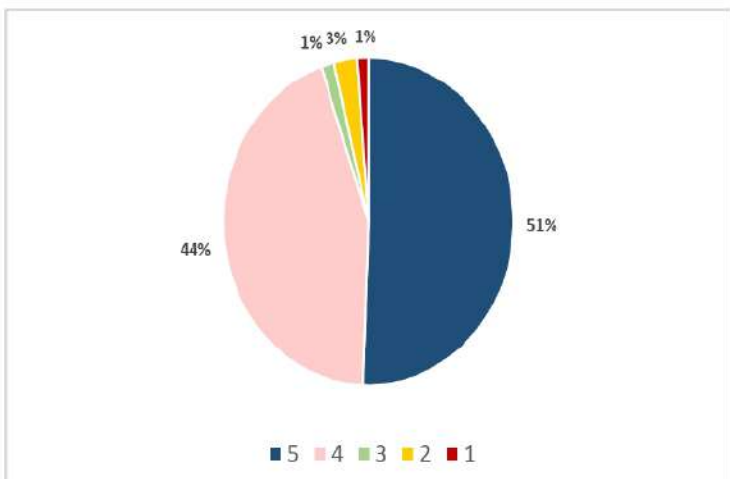

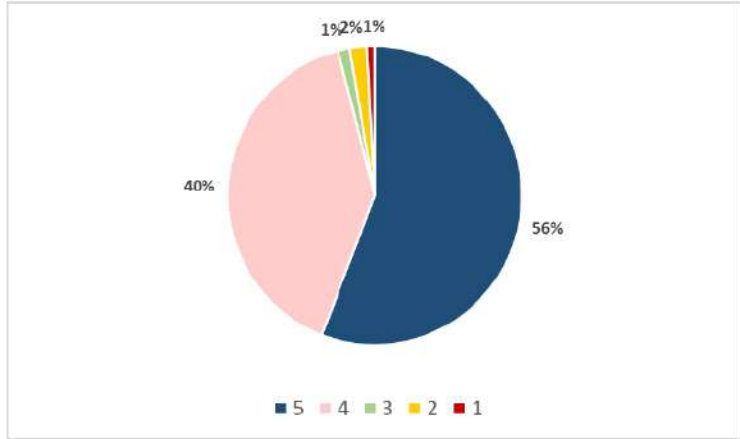
Question 8: Do you get requisite resources and guidance from teachers for legal research?

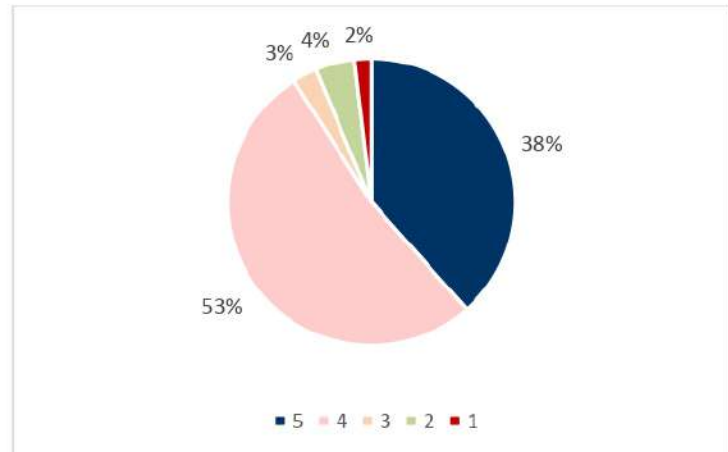
Question 9: Are you satisfied with events organized by the college such as sports, cultural activities, debates, competitions, Legal visits, guest lectures, workshops etc.?

Overall Observations

1. Around 70 percent of the students assigned ratings ranging from 4 to 5 for the curriculum having sufficient balance between theoretical and practical knowledge.
2. Majority of the students expressed contentment with the prompt covering of the syllabus alongside revision.
3. Over 90 percent of the students concur that teachers encourage participative learning and provide opportunities to learn and grow.
4. Around 81 percent of students appear to be satisfied with the teaching methodology and learning tools employed by teachers for effective learning.
5. Only a small number of students find the course and reference materials in the college library satisfactory, indicating a need for attention and improvement.
6. Students expressed satisfaction with the range of activities organized by the college, including sports, cultural events, debates, competitions, legal visits, guest lectures, workshops, etc., rating them between 4 and 5.
7. A significant no. of students rated between 4 to 5 on given the opportunities to clarify their doubts, concerns, and suggestions.

Actions Taken

1. Based on received data, the Institute focused on designing lecture plans that accommodate more practical aspects like discussions, debates, quizzes, case study etc to be added to teaching methodologies.
2. The college library has been furnished with books of the latest edition and journals as per the syllabus curriculum for students to peruse and different online databases were made available for instigating research.
3. More legal visits were arranged to inculcate a practical approach in the students.
4. Debates, Seminars and Moot Court Competitions were organized to develop the approach of participating in extra-curricular activities.
5. Additional extracurricular activities such as lexis nexis workshops, library exposure, research paper writing workshop etc are incorporated into the curriculum to enhance students' overall development.

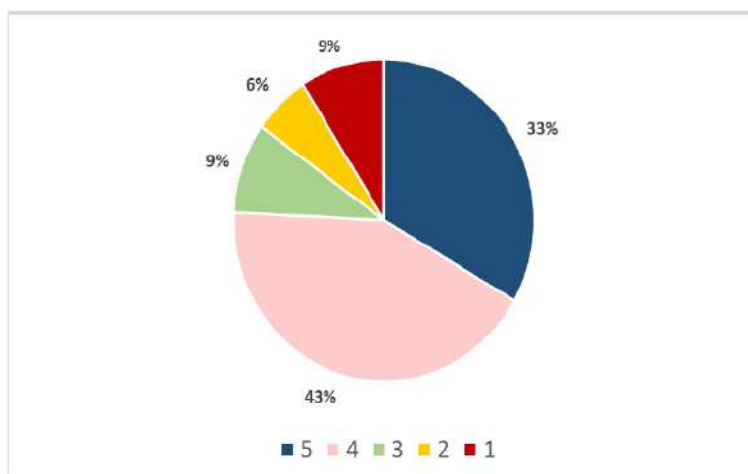

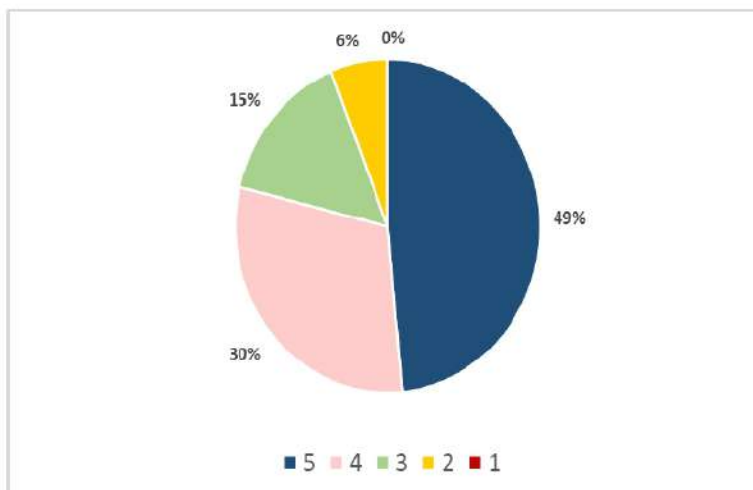
Question 1: How satisfied are you with the syllabus prescribed by the University?

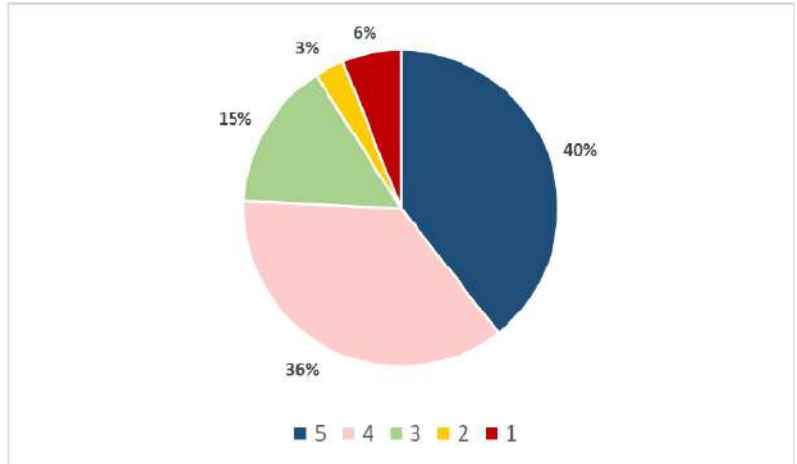
Question 2: How satisfied are you with the infrastructure and facilities provided to you by the college?

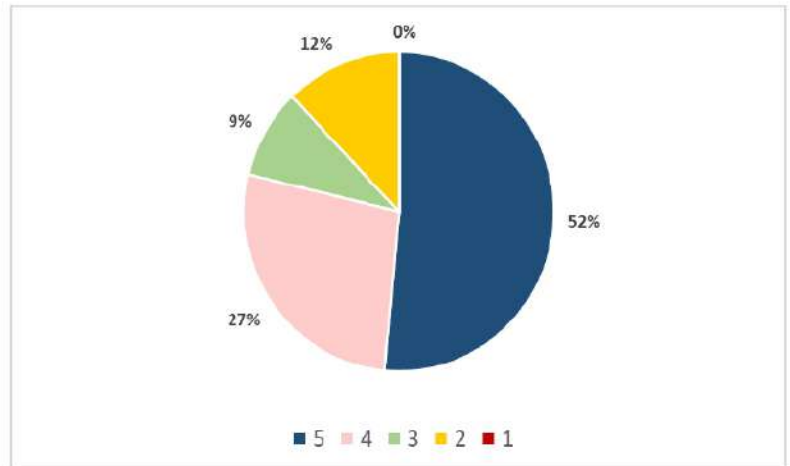
Question 3: How satisfied are you with the classroom infrastructure such as ICT tools etc.?

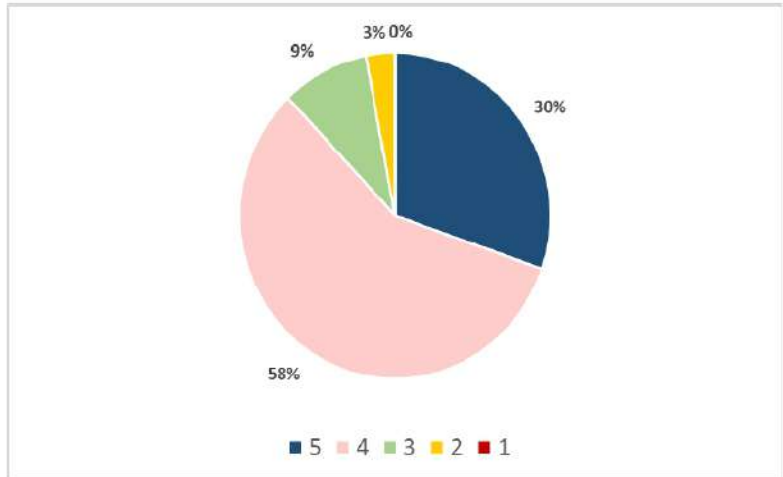
Question 4: Do you feel the college has requisite books, research journals, online subscriptions in library and other research facilities available?

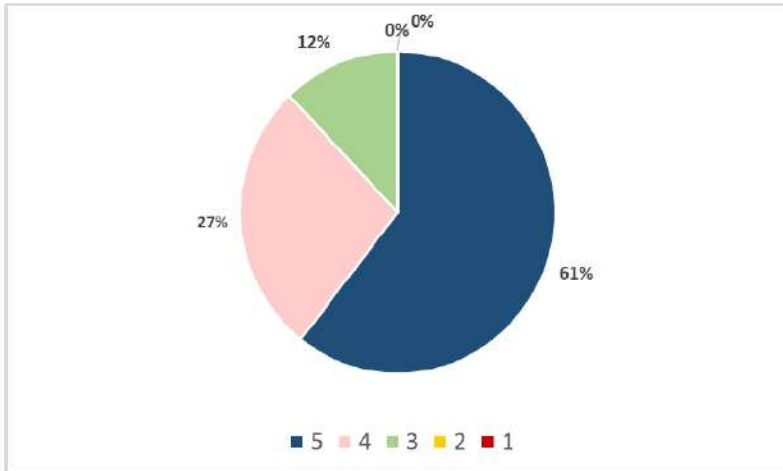
Question 5: Are you satisfied with the college policies in relation to seminars, conferences, and workshops for faculties?

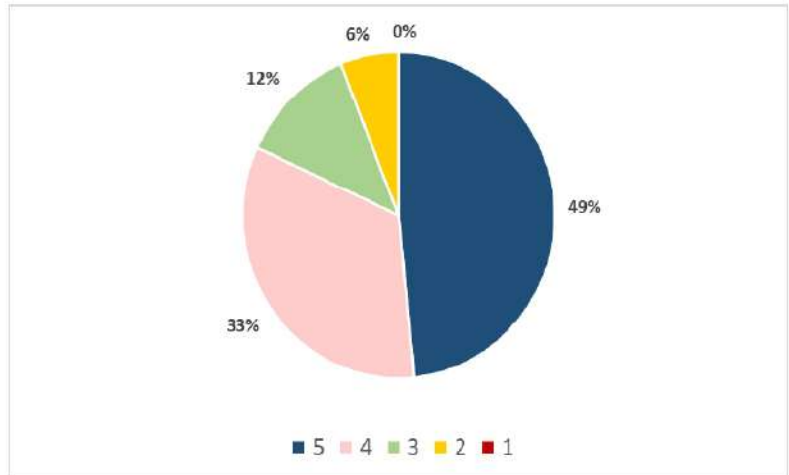
Question 6: Are you given the proper opportunity to participate and express your views and concerns, and give suggestions in academic matters?

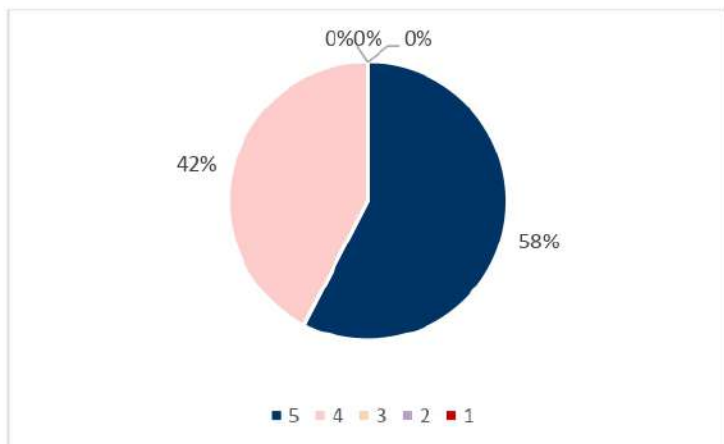
Question 7: Are you satisfied with the practical training, seminars, workshops, and other activities organized by the college for the students?

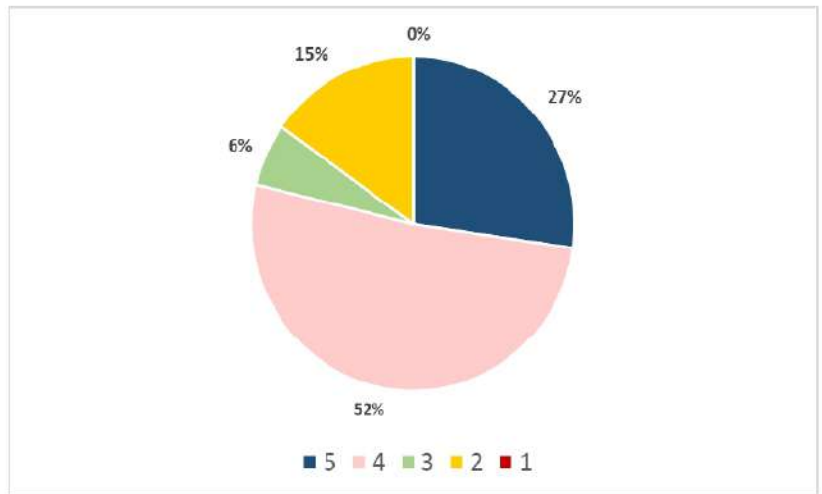
Question 8: According to you, are there enough curricular and co-curricular activities organized for the students?

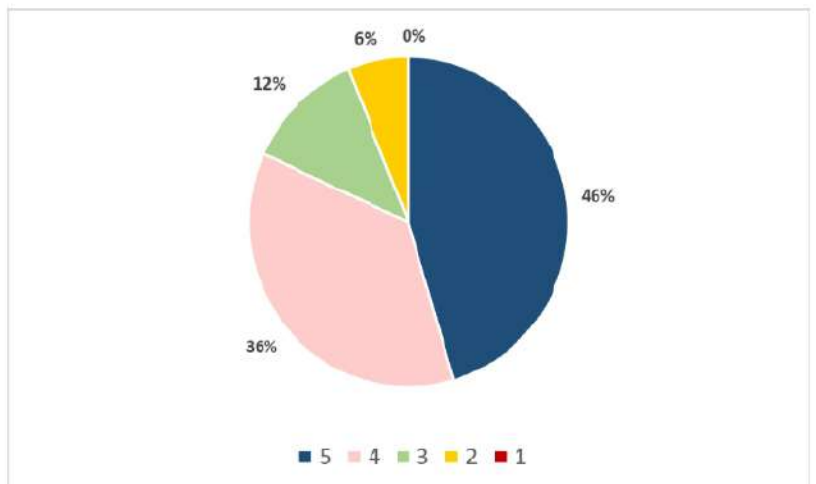
Question 9: Are you satisfied with the training and development programs organized by the college for the faculty members?

OVERALL OBSERVATIONS

1. The teachers expressed satisfaction with the college's infrastructure and facilities, giving ratings between 4 to 5.
2. Observations suggest that around 30 percent of the faculties find the university-prescribed syllabus non satisfactory, signaling a necessity for improvement and amendments.
3. Majority of the teachers were content with the availability of necessary books, research journals, online subscriptions, and library and research facilities.
4. Teachers rated between 4 to 5 for favorable opportunities provided for their active participation, expression of views and concerns, as well as offering suggestions on academic affairs.



5. Observations suggest that there is room for further improvement in the faculty training program.
6. Teachers were satisfied with the college policies in relation to seminars, conferences and workshops for faculties and rated in between 4 and 5.
7. More than 80 percent of faculties rated in between 4 and 5 for the equal treatment given and also given the opportunities to address their suggestions.

ACTIONS TAKEN

1. Teachers are being given motivation to pursue research degrees and were given support from the college.
2. The Institute has resolved to conduct the Faculty Training Program bi-monthly, aiming to enhance the skills and expertise of faculty members.
3. The Head of the Department has considered the suggestions provided by the faculty members to explore further avenues for improvement and refinement of the infrastructure and other facilities.
4. As part of the faculty development, the Institute has introduced additional online databases aimed at providing teachers with access to high-quality research materials, thereby facilitating their academic endeavors.
5. Extra classes are being organized for students to enrich their practical understanding and address additional aspects of law not covered in the current syllabus, tailored to contemporary scenarios.

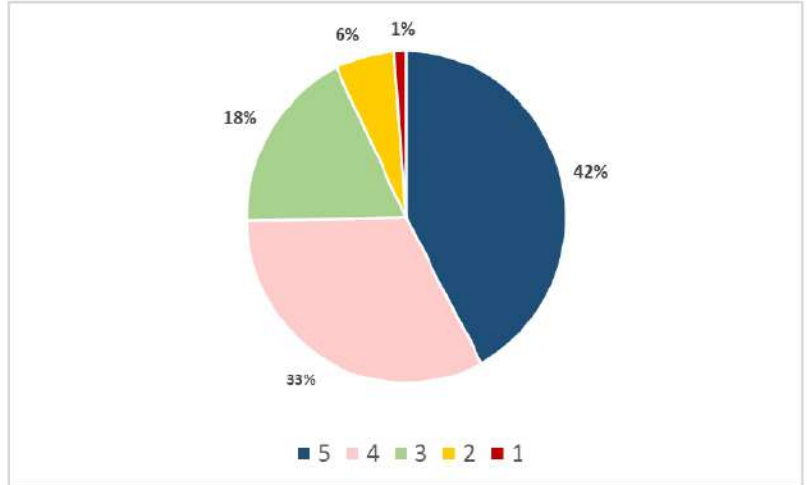

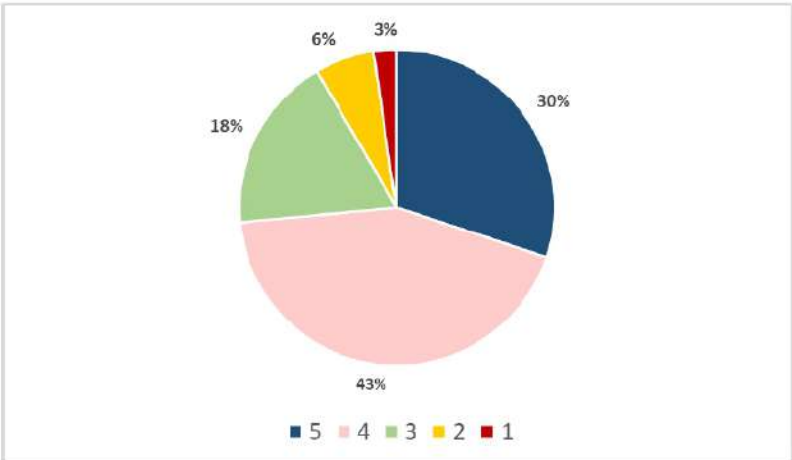
Question 1: How satisfied are you with the overall learning at Ishan?

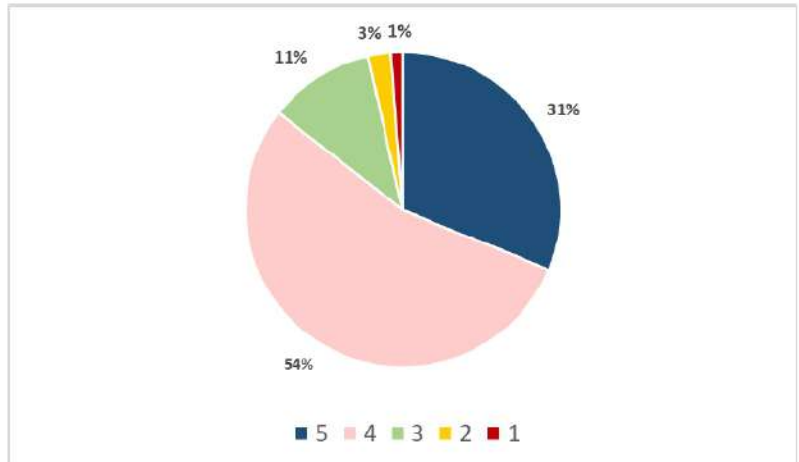
Question 2: How satisfied are you with the subject knowledge and practical knowledge you gained during the program?

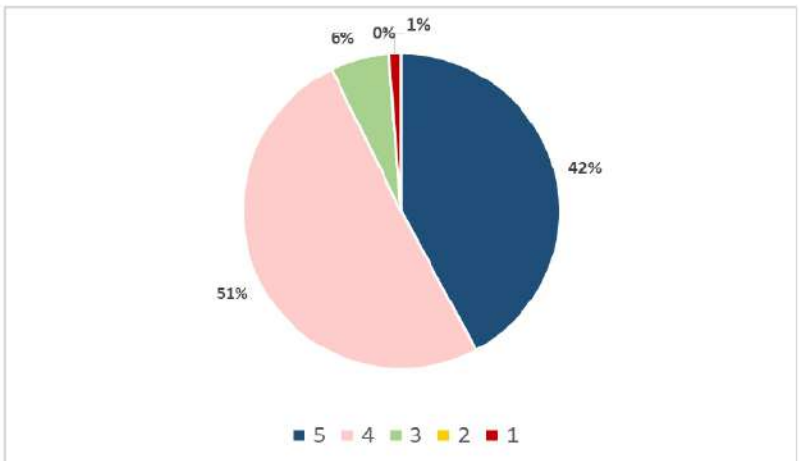
Question 3: Do you find your practical knowledge and skills up to date with your professional requirements at work?

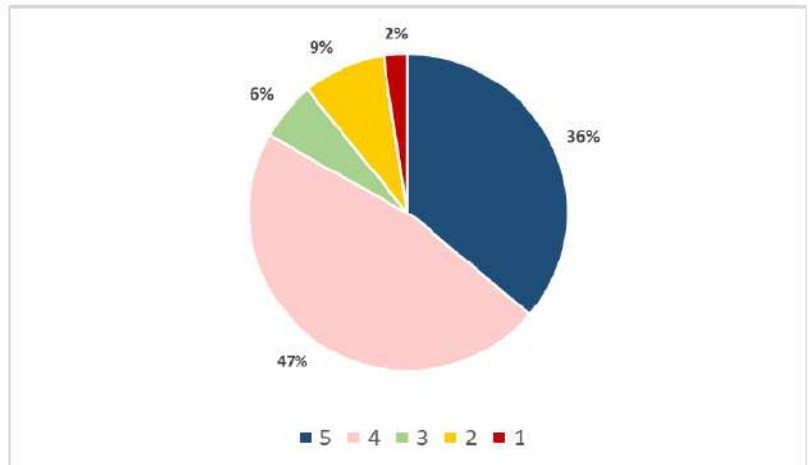
Question 4: How satisfied are you with the co-curricular activities, seminars, workshops and other academic activities organized by the Institute?

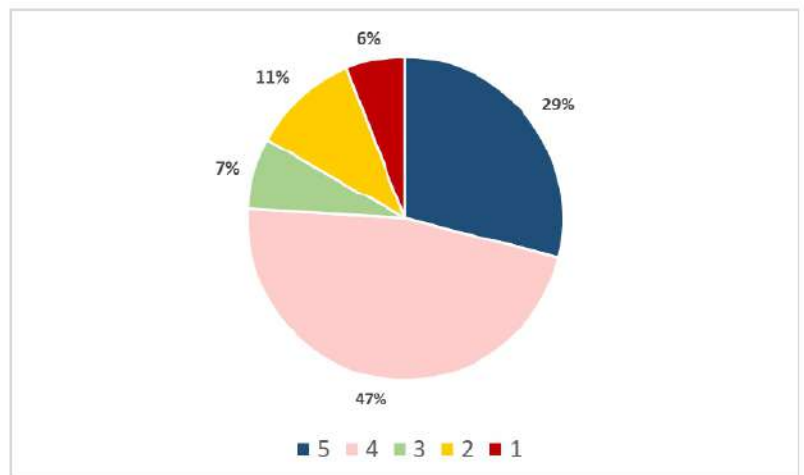
Question 5: How helpful were the teachings of the Institute in your professional life?

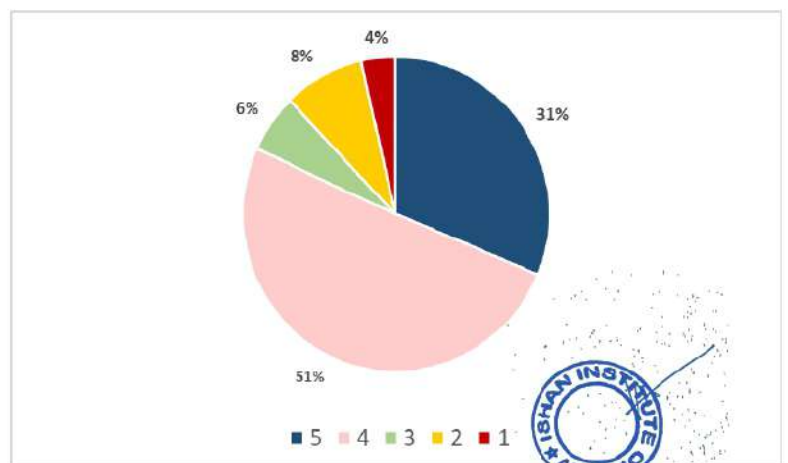
Question 6 How well was the curriculum designed to cater to the needs of your professional life?

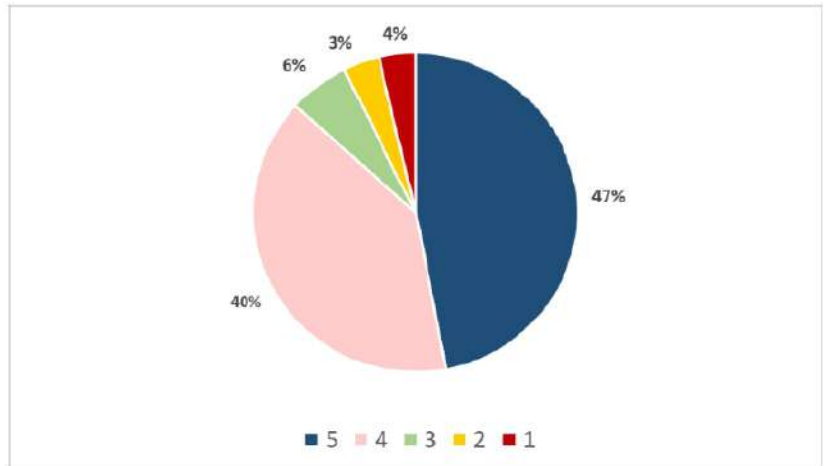
Question 7: Do you agree that the sports and cultural activities organized by the Institute helped in shaping and grooming your personality?

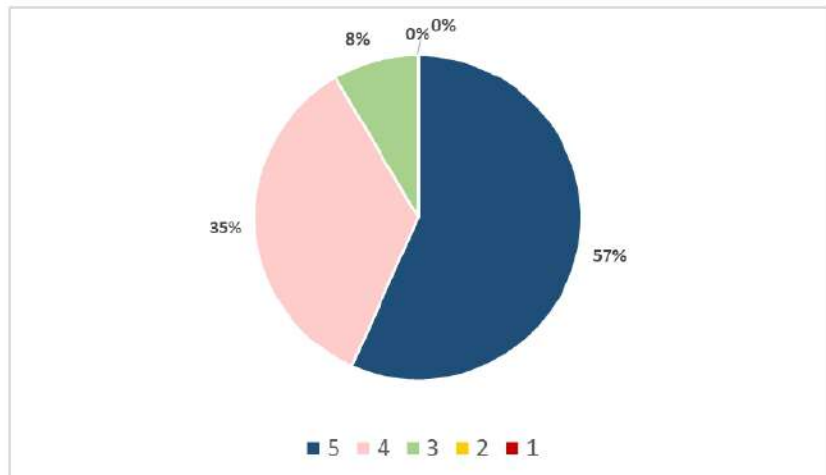
Question 8: How satisfied are you with the guidance provided to pursue higher education?

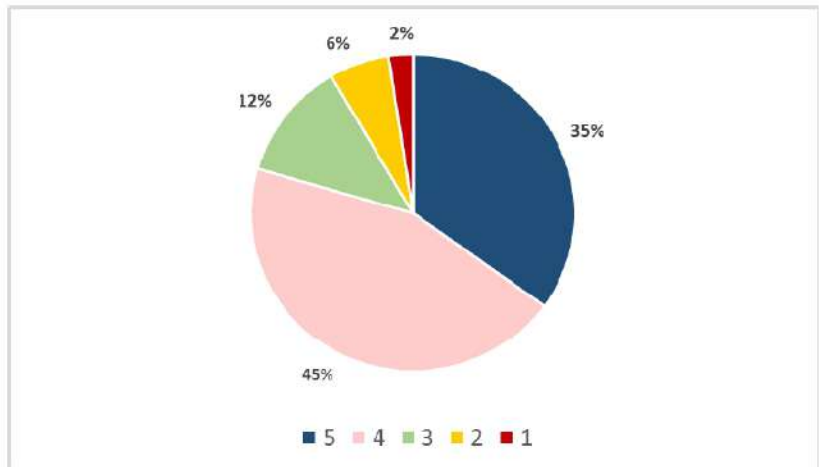
Question 9: Are you satisfied with the initiatives taken by the Institute towards alumni relations and engagement?

OVERALL OBSERVATIONS

1. Overall learning experience at Ishan is rated excellent by the majority of the Alumni.
2. Around 70 percent alumni are satisfied with the subject knowledge and practical training that they gained during the program, rated between 4-5.
3. Nearly everyone has opined that the co-curricular activities, seminars, workshops and other academic activities organized by the Institute are extremely good.
4. Over 80% of the alumni express high satisfaction and provide positive feedback, stating that the curriculum effectively addresses their professional needs.
5. The alumni expressed satisfaction with the institute's efforts in fostering alumni relations.

ACTIONS TAKEN

1. The Institute has taken proactive measures to enhance its infrastructure by integrating advanced ICT tools. Additionally, the introduction of its own research journal provides students with a platform to publish their research papers, thereby fostering academic growth and dissemination of knowledge.
2. The institute organized more workshops and competitions with a primary focus on fostering the skill development of students.
3. Updated researched study material was made available to future batches for better understanding.
4. More placement drives have been arranged in the college.

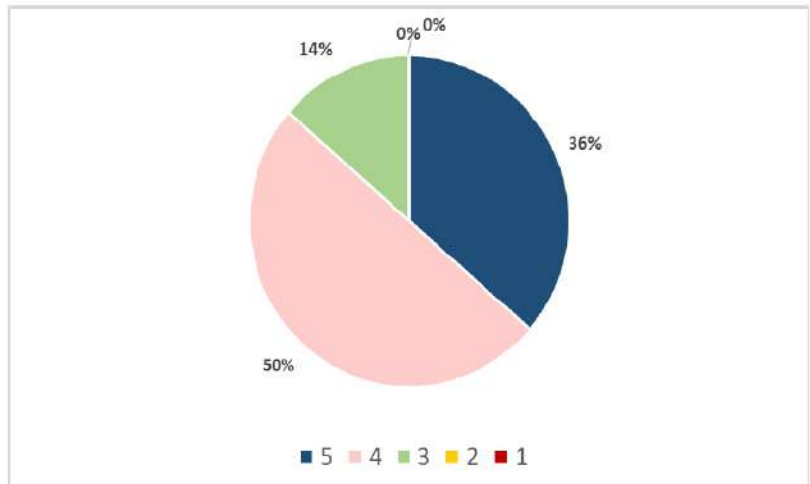

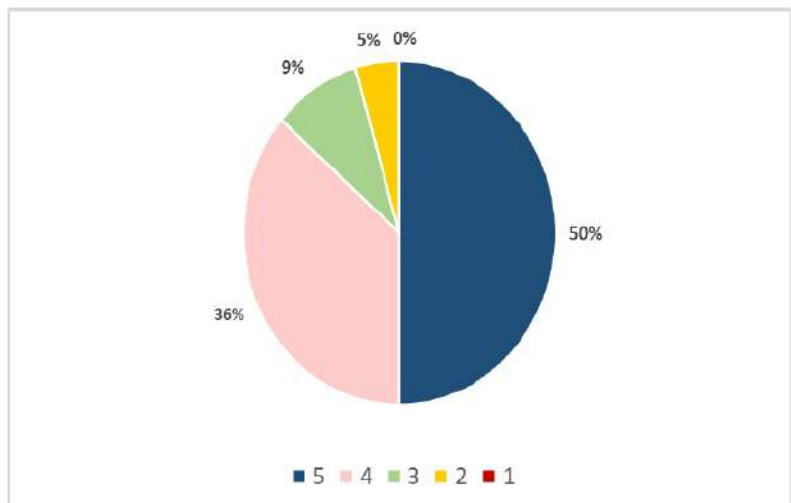
Question 1: Curriculum taught by the Institute to the employee.

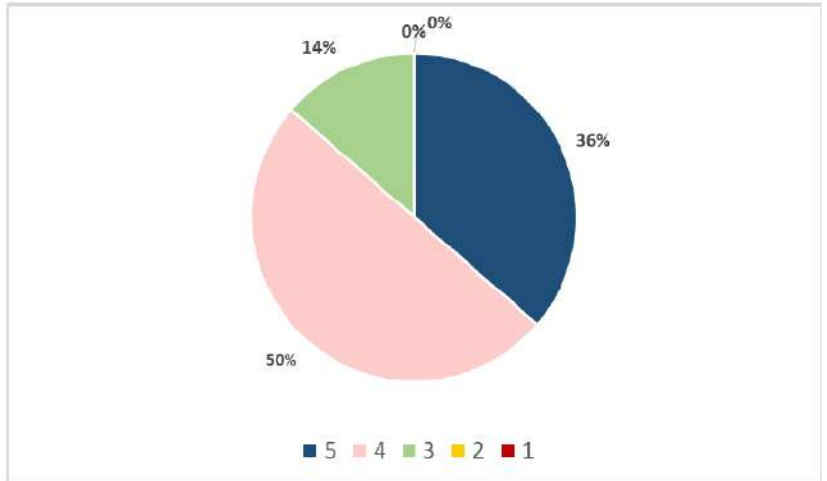
Question 2: Level of Communication Skills and Technical Contribution.

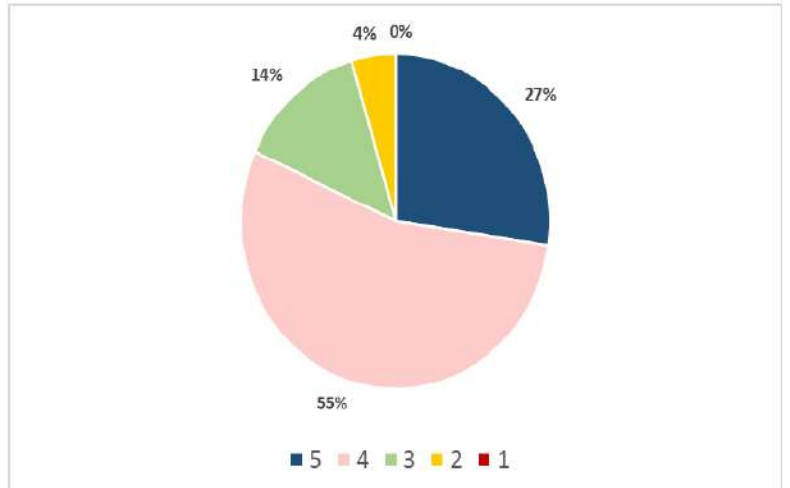
Question 3: Contribution to Ethical and Social Responsibilities.

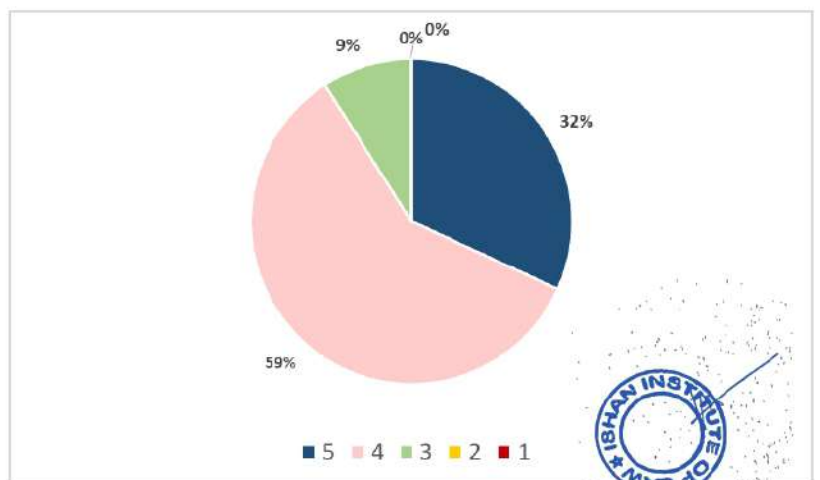
Question 4: Openness to learning new skills.

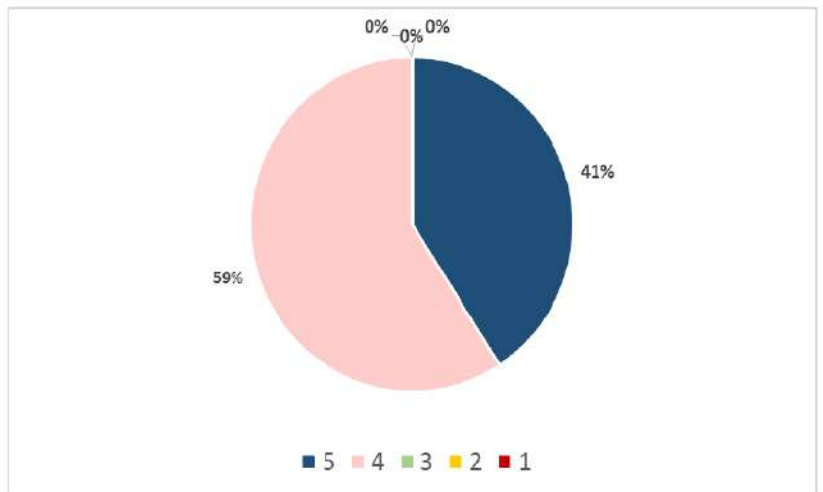
Question 5: Overall relationship with the seniors/subordinates/peers.

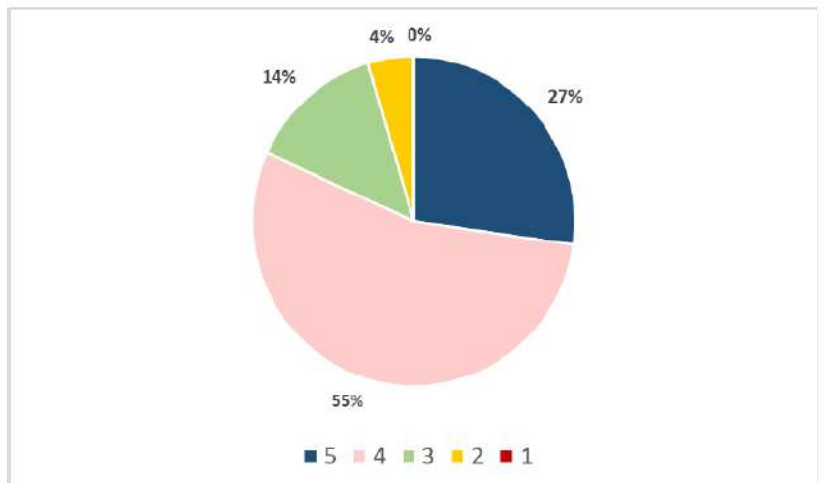
Question 6: Ability to work as a part of a team.

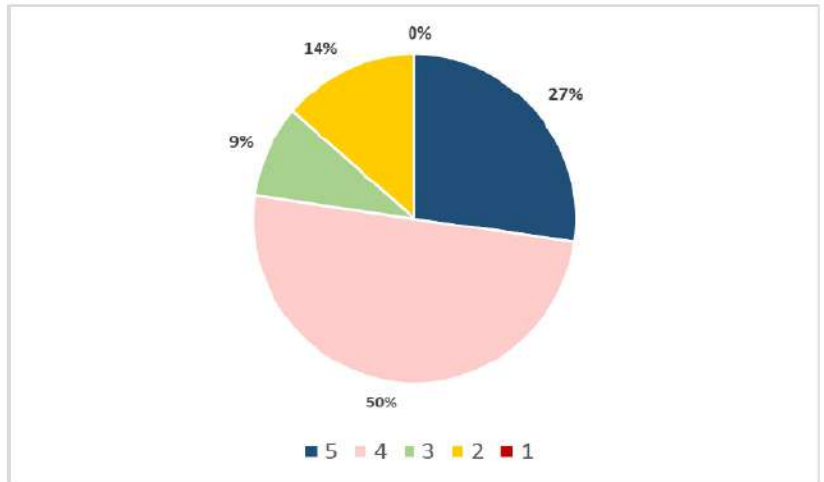
Question 7: Contribution towards achieving the organizational goals.

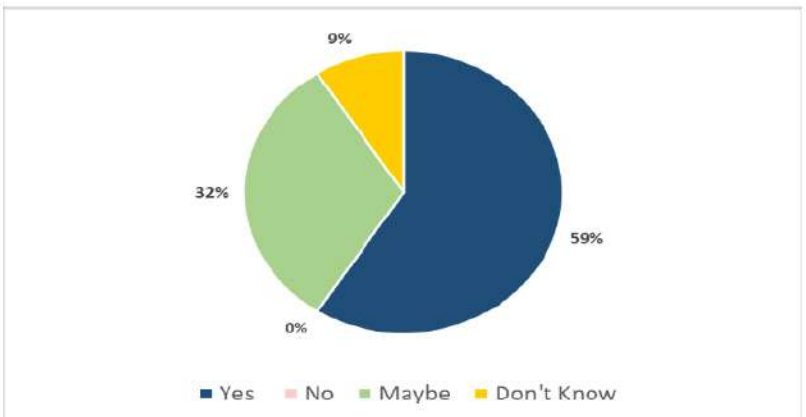
Question 8: Willingness to receive suggestions/feedback.

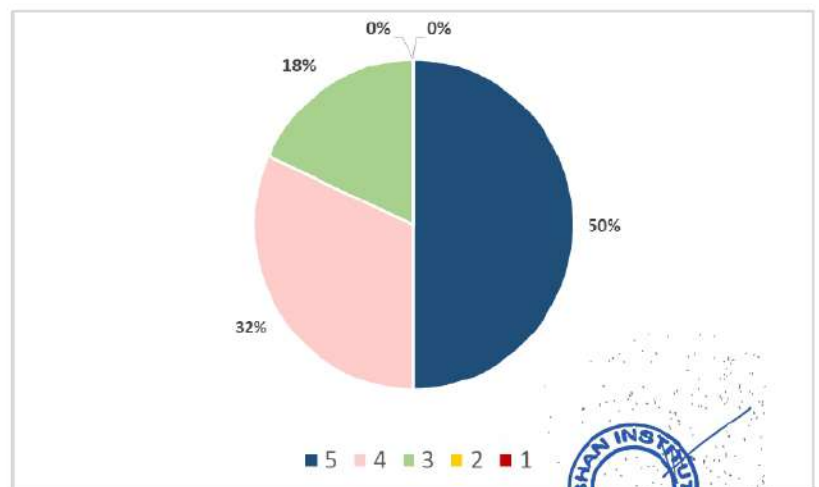
Question 9: Would you think of recruiting more students from Ishan institute of Law in future?

Overall Observation

1. Over 80 percent of employers expressed satisfaction with the level of communication skills and technical contribution by the students.
2. All the employers expressed high satisfaction and provided positive feedback on the students' ability to work as a part of a team, rating in between 4-5.
3. Employers gave students an average rating of 4 for their openness to receiving suggestions and feedback.

ACTIONS TAKEN

1. To upgrade the skills of the students, the Institute have organized and will continue to organize more often various skill development workshops.

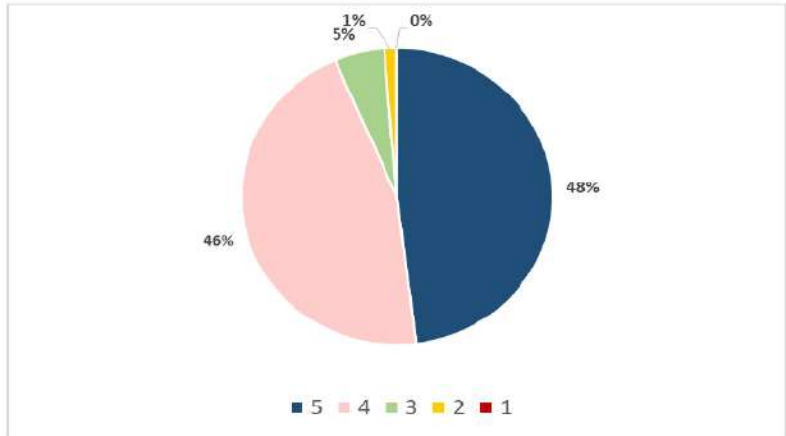

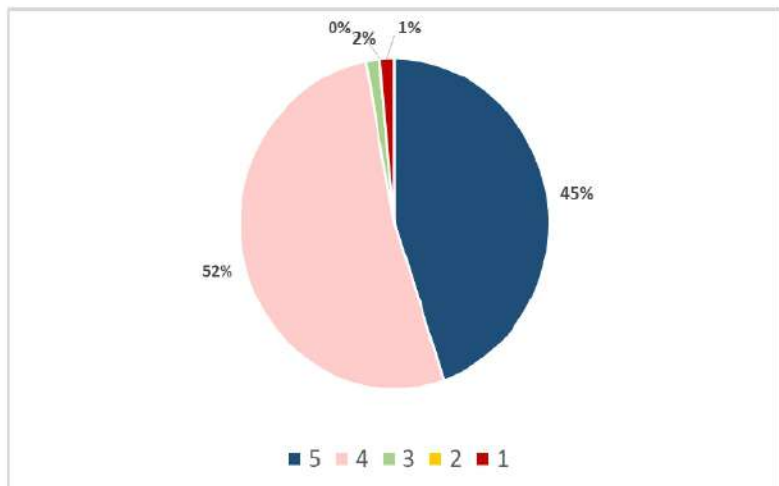
Question 1: How satisfied are you with the admission procedure by the Institution/ University?

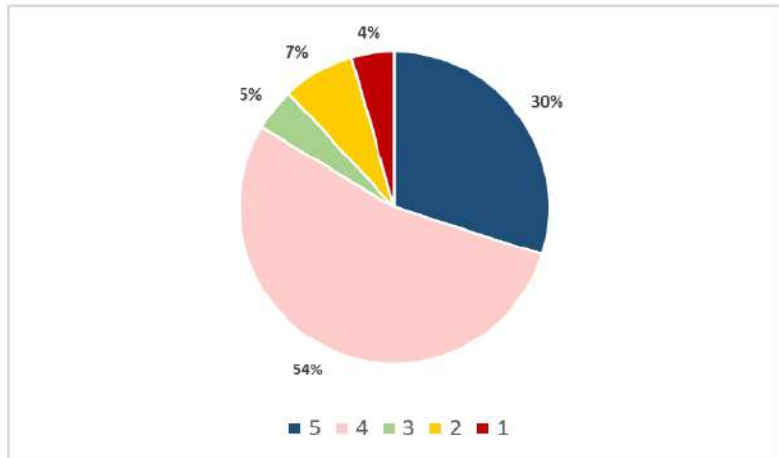
Question 2: How would you rate the academic co-curricular and sports activities organized by the Institute?

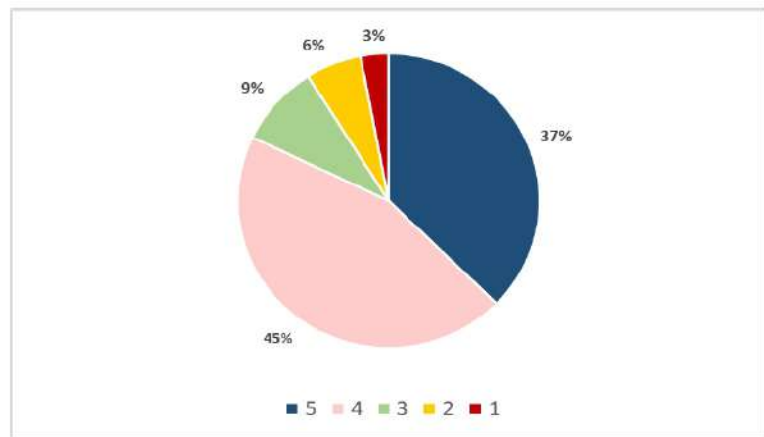
Question 3: Are you satisfied with the cooperation provided by the administrative department?

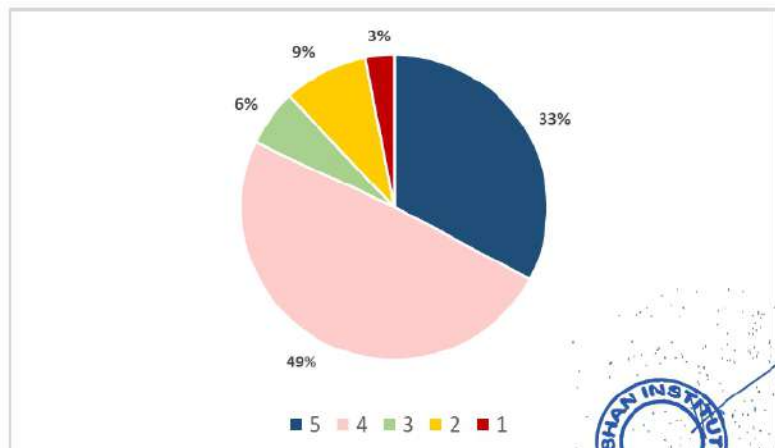
Question 4: Are you satisfied with the skills and knowledge being imparted to your ward?

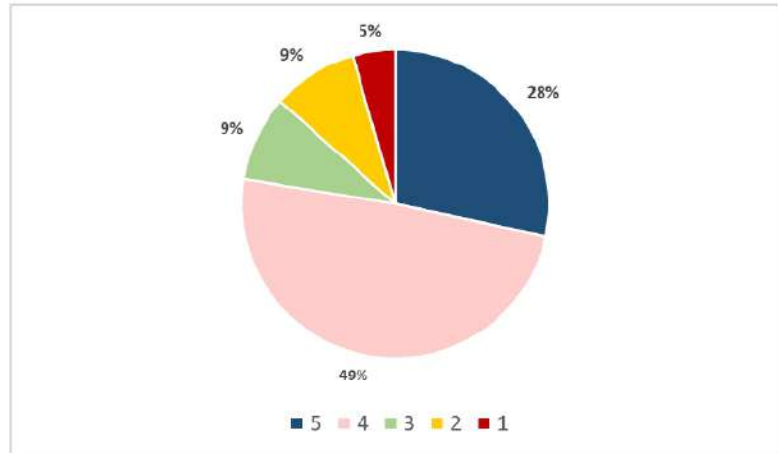
Question 5: Are you satisfied with the updates and the level of communication between the college and the parents?

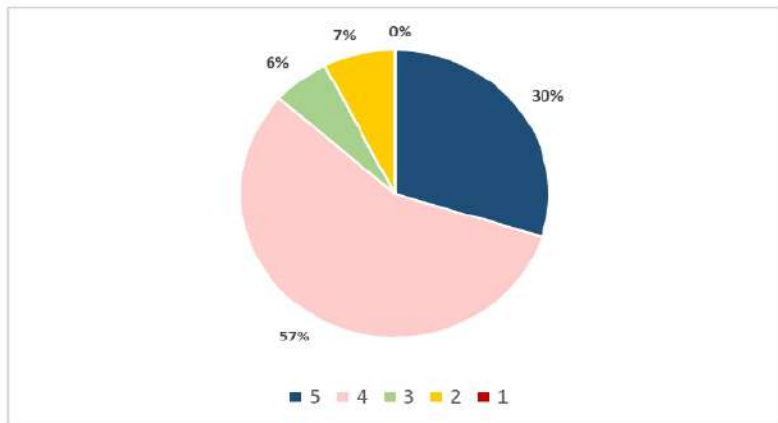
Question 6: Are you satisfied with the practical exposure and career-oriented support provided by the Institution?

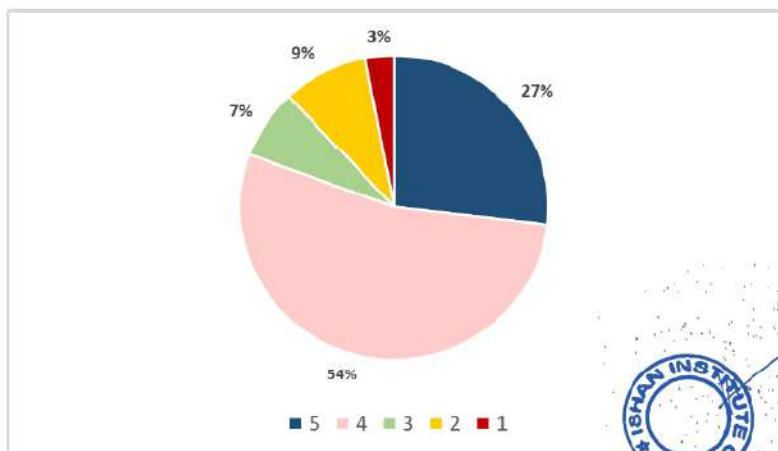
Question 7: How satisfied are you with the way your ideas and concerns are being addressed?

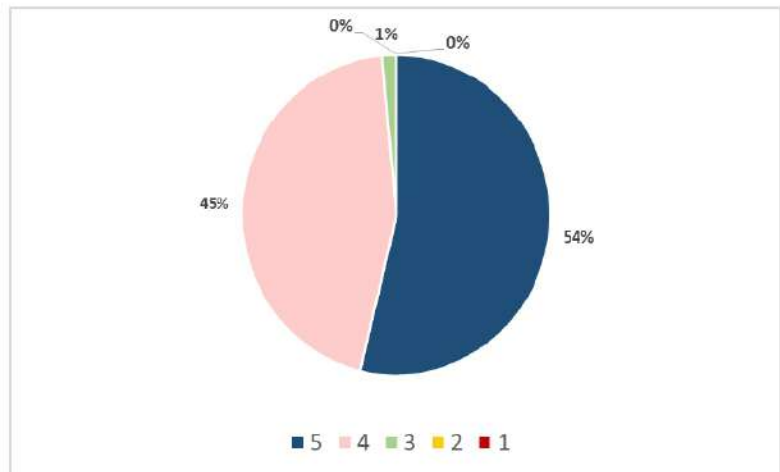
Question 8: Do you think that the institute' is conducive for the overall growth and development of your ward?

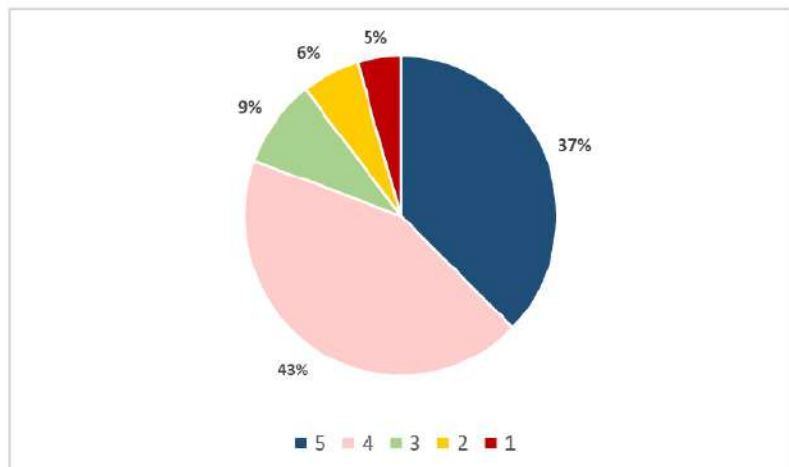
Question 9: Are you satisfied with the security arrangements and safety measures taken by the Institute?

OVERALL OBSERVATIONS

1. Above 90 percent of parents are satisfied with the admission procedure by the Institute/University.
2. Parents seem to be satisfied with the cooperation administered by the administrative department regarding any query and rated in between 4-5.
3. Roughly 82 percent of parents provided ratings ranging from 4 to 5 and are of the opinion that the level of communication between college and the parents is excellent.
4. Parents appear to be less satisfied with the practical exposure and career-oriented support provided by the institution to their children, suggesting a need for improvement and enhancement.



5. It was reassuring to observe that nearly every parent expressed satisfaction with the security arrangements and safety measures implemented by the institute.

ACTIONS TAKEN

1. Based on the feedback, extra classes are being taken more often by the faculties to bring out more clarity on the subjects on the recommendation of the parents.
2. Mentor-Mentee meeting will be conducted on regular intervals to entertain the problems of the students and parents.
3. Regular sessions on career counseling are to be held to familiarize students with various career options and opportunities.
4. Regular inspections of the hostel mess and college canteen are being carried out for the benefit of the hostellers.
