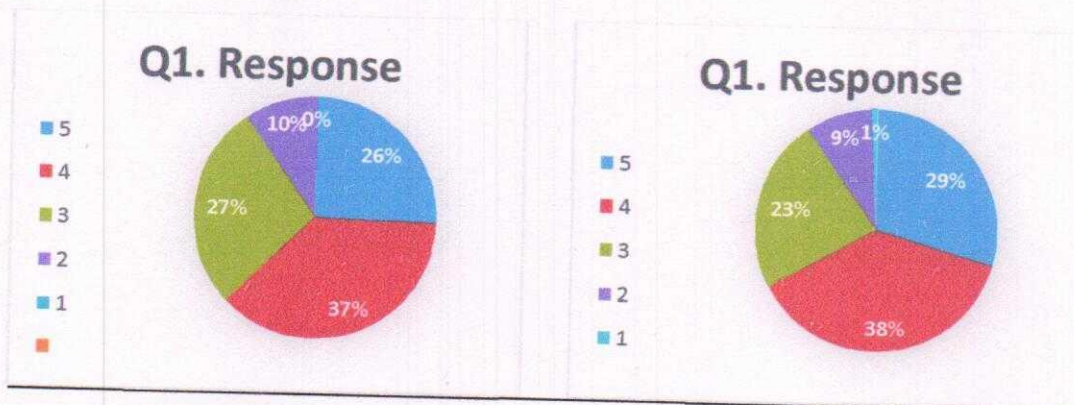

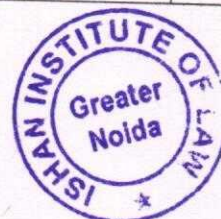
Question 1: Do you agree that the curriculum has sufficient balance between theoretical and practical knowledge?



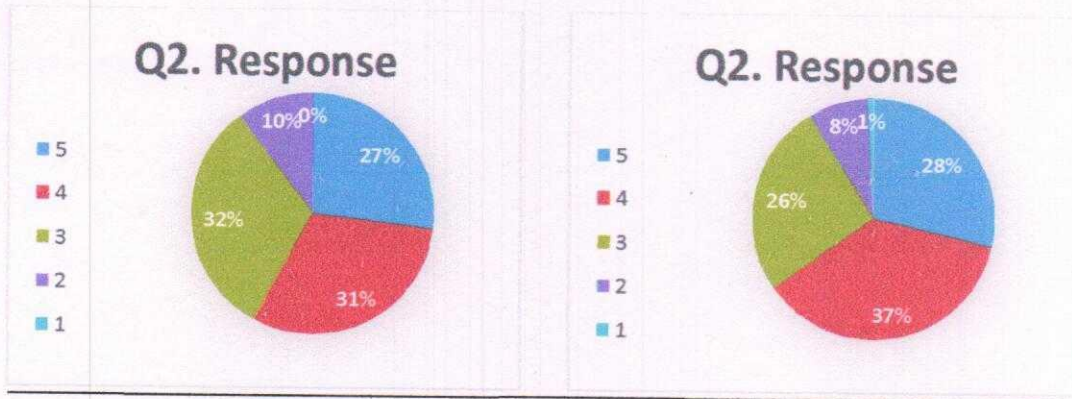

Question 2: The syllabus provides with adequate knowledge of the fundamental concepts?

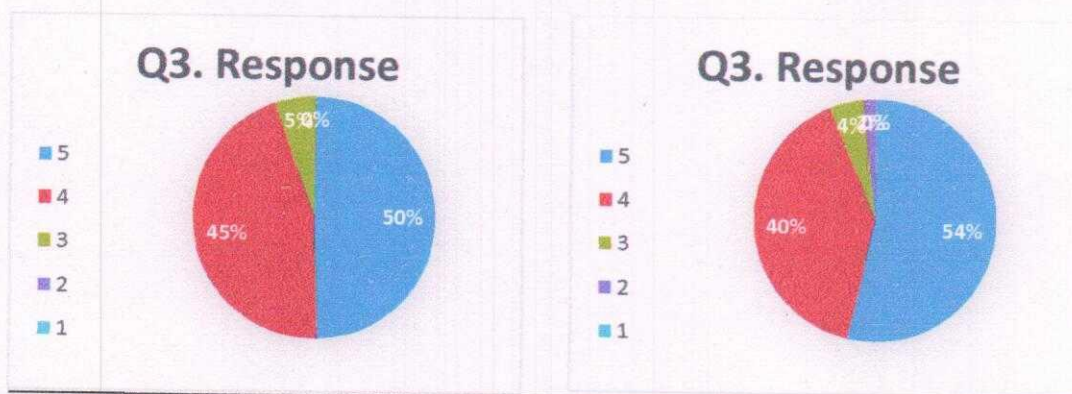

Question 4: The teachers provide the students opportunities to learn and grow?



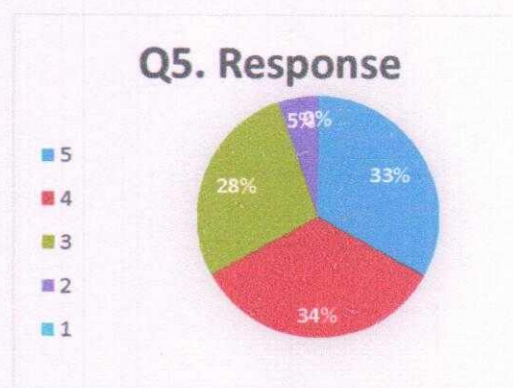
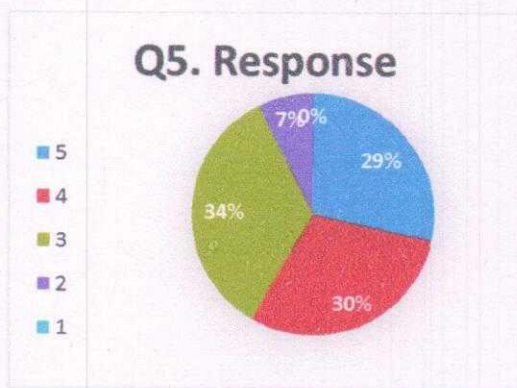

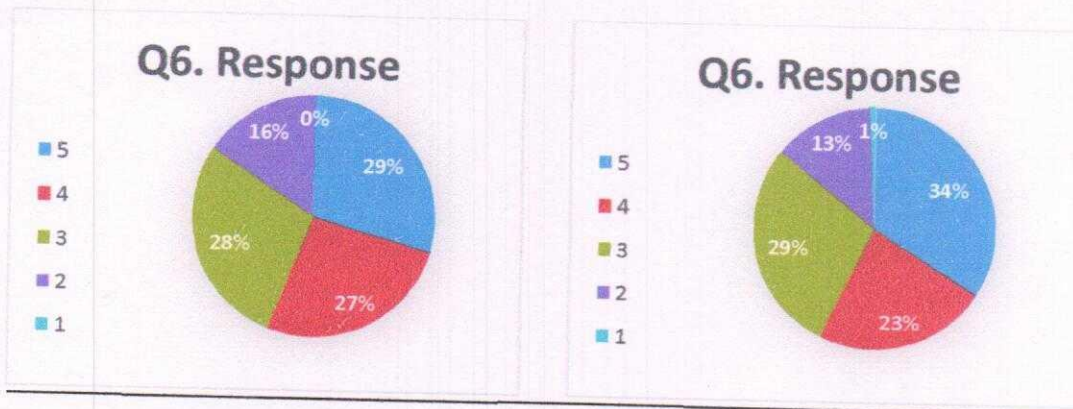

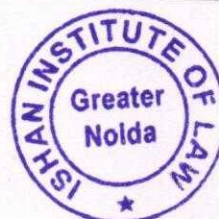

Question 8: Were you given enough opportunities and encouragement to participate in extra-curricular and co-curricular activities?



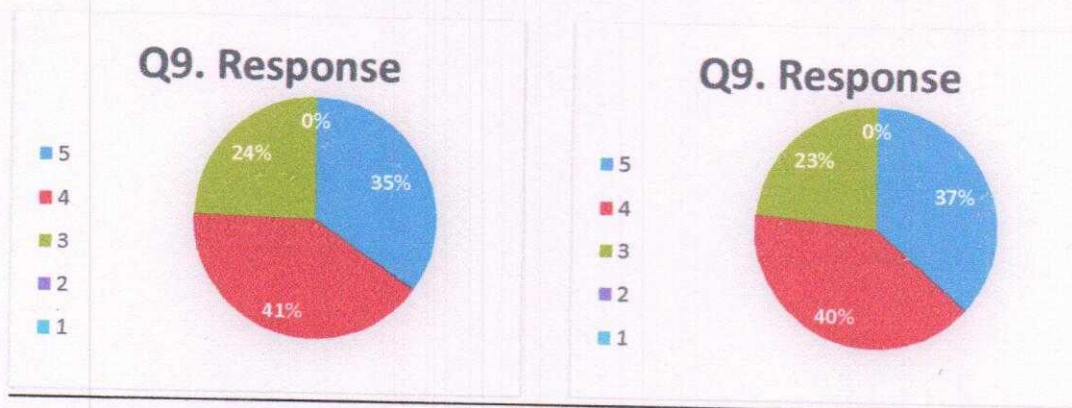

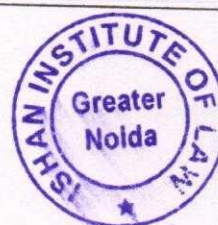
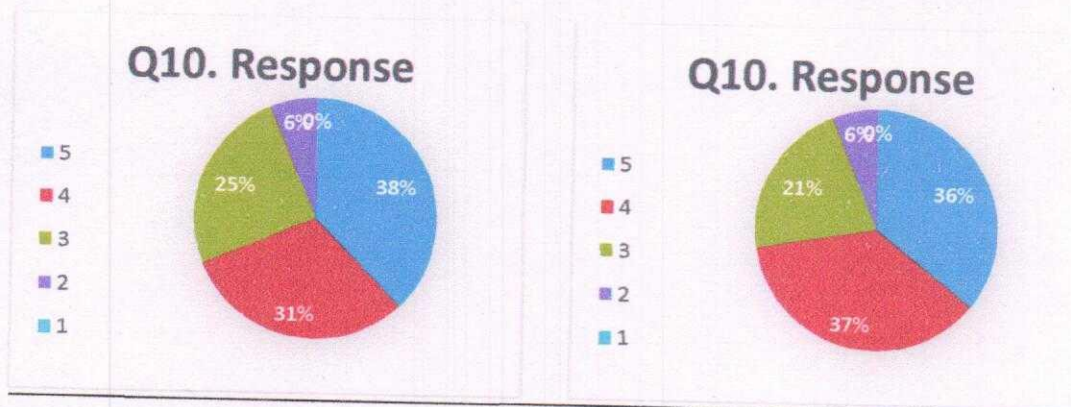

Overall Observation

1. More than 75 percent of the students rated 4 for the blend of the theoretical and practical approach taken by the teachers for completion of syllabus.
2. Around 70 percent of the students rated in between 4 and 5 for completion of the syllabus on time followed by the revision classes conducted.
3. 70 percent of the students were satisfied by the opportunities given to learn and grow by involving them into extra-curricular activities such as moots, seminar and conferences.
4. More than 80 percent of the students rated in between 4 and 5 for the good atmosphere of the class and inclusion of necessary tools in learning.
5. Around 75 percent of the students rated 4 for the type of activities organized by the college such as sports, cultural activities, debates, quiz competitions, field visits, guest lectures, workshops etc.

Action Taken

1. Field visits are arranged to inculcate practical approach in the students.
2. Different online databases were made available for instigating research.
3. Seminar and Conferences, Inter-college Moot Courts are organized in order to develop the approach of participating in extra-curricular activities.

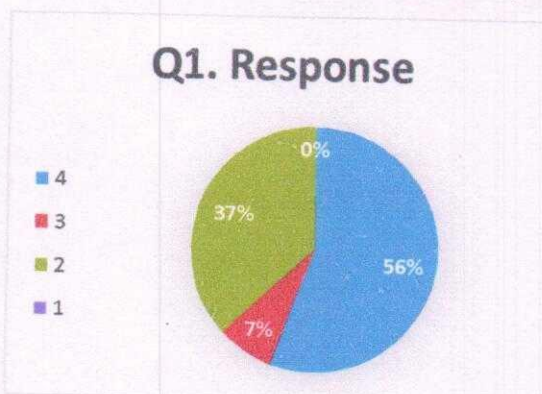

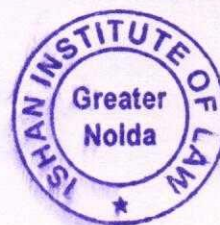

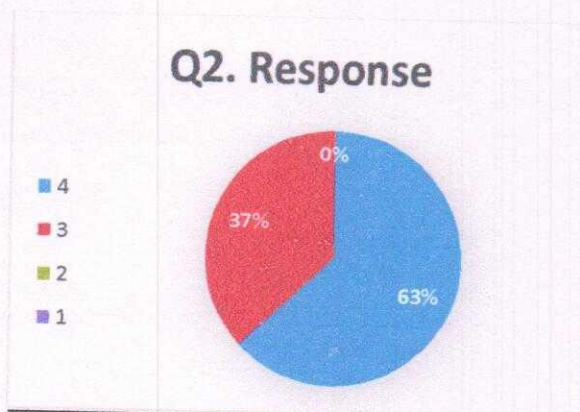
Question 1: How satisfied are you with the syllabus provided by the university?

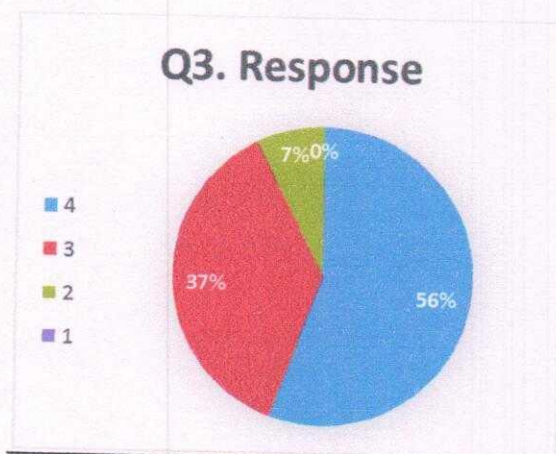
Question 2: Is the infrastructure provided to you by the college in class room satisfactory?





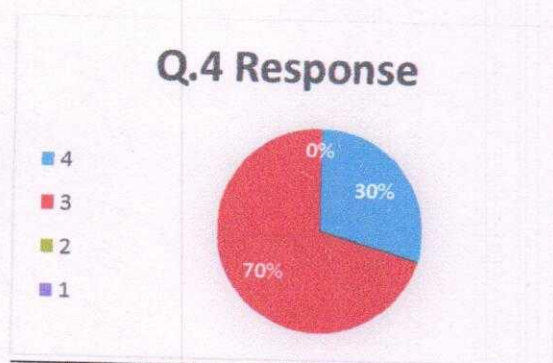

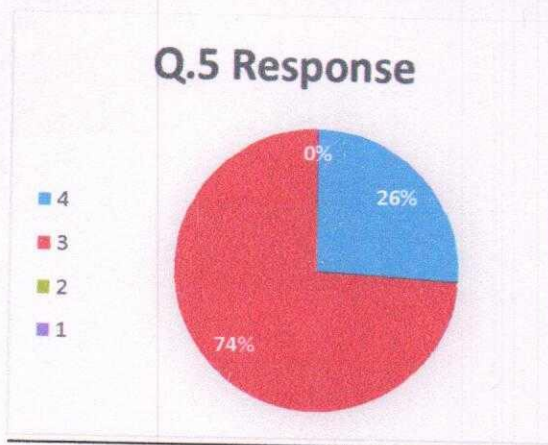
Question 4: According to you, are the co-curricular activities designed during the year appropriate?

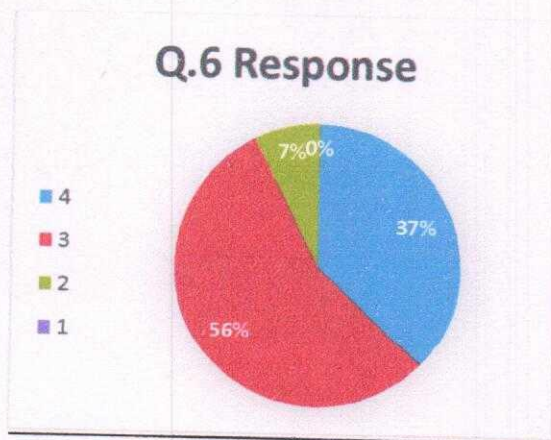


Question 5: How satisfied are you with the facilities given to you by the management?

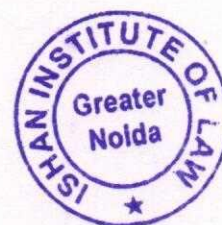

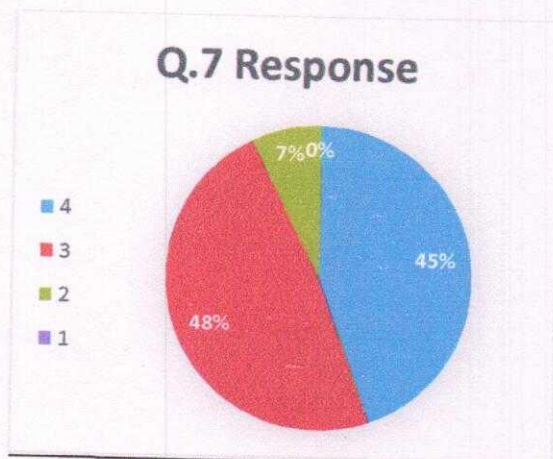
Question 6: Are you given proper opportunity to express your concern in the academic matters?

Overall Observation

1. More than 70 Percent of the teachers rated 4 for the curriculum provided by the university.
2. Around 75 percent of the teachers are satisfied by the infrastructure provided by the college such as classroom, library, IT Labs, etc.
3. 75 percent of the faculties rated in between 4 and 5 for the co-curricular activities designed during the year and also with the facilities provided by the management.
4. More than 80 percent of the teachers are satisfied for given proper opportunity to express their concern in the academic matters.

Action Taken

1. Teachers included more practical approach by giving projects which require extensive research.
2. More reference books added in the library to help teachers to prepare well researched materials for students.
3. Every teachers are given online database to provide them ease at work.
4. Desktop are installed on each table of the teachers.



EMPLOYER'S REPORT

Employer Survey was circulated to all the Employers of the students who graduated this year in July 2019. A majority of the students chose to go for independent Practice / Proprietary Firm, thus Employer Survey is not applicable in their case. Some of the employers replied through Confidential Letters. The observation and action taken are based on the same.

OVERALL OBSERVATION

1. Drafting legal Documents in an appropriate manner by the students was appreciated by the employer but upgrading the legal knowledge looking into the current scenario was expected by the Employer.
2. Employer praised the knowledge about the Technology and Client handling Nature but insisted more practical approach in Client Interaction.
3. Legal Knowledge in Students of Ishan Law Institute was recognized by the Employer.

ACTIONS TAKEN

1. For Building team work, Group Discussions were conducted by the Institute.
2. Workshop on Personality Development was organized by the Institute on regular Intervals.
3. To improve IT skills in Students, training was given by the experts.

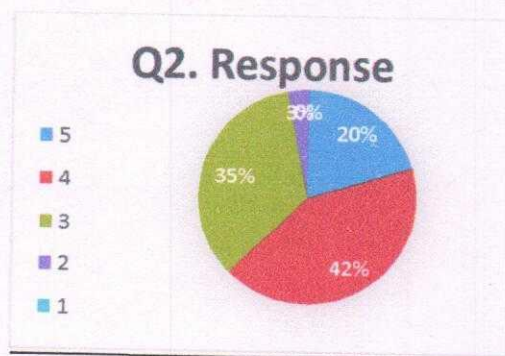

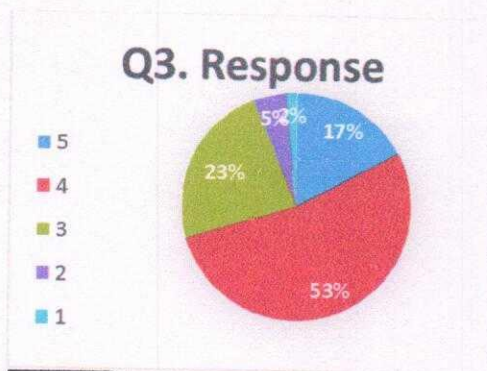

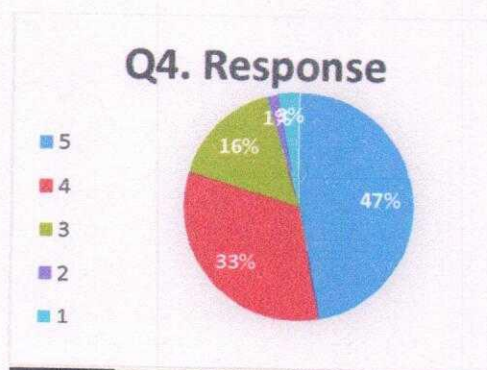


3. How helpful were the teachings of college in your professional life?

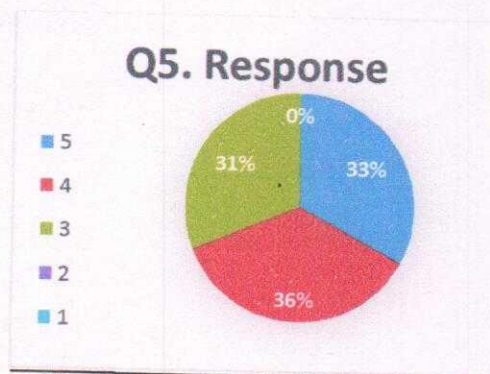

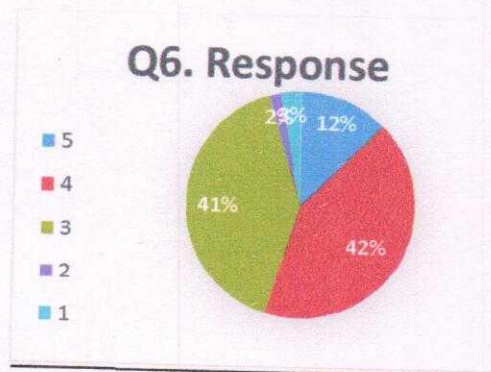


5. Skills/ competencies developed during course of your study

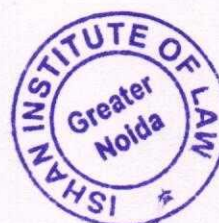

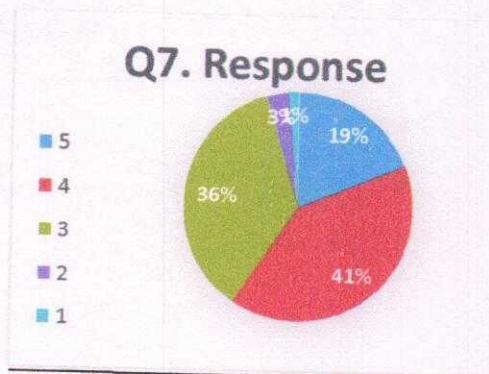
6. How would rate the course that you have learnt in relation to your current work profile

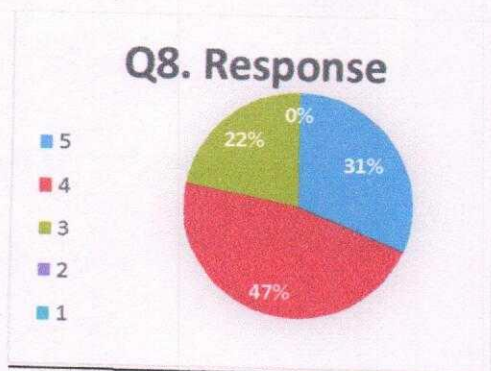


7. Your overall academic experience.

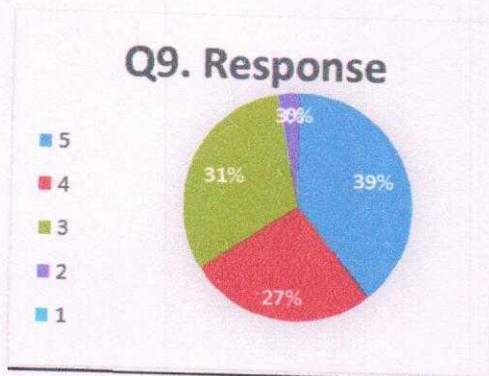
8. Integration of theory and practical in class

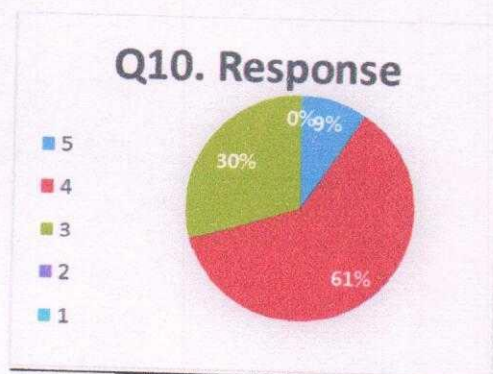


9. Availability of online resources and library digital resources & reading material support

Overall Observations

1. The Students rated in between 3 and 4 for the experience they received in relation to Internal Assessment such as Debates, moots, Quiz, Presentations, etc.
2. Around 65 Percent of the Students rated 4 for the skills and knowledge gained during the course and it helped them in their present employment.
3. More than 70 percent of the Alumni of the Institutions were satisfied with the methodology used by faculties during teaching.
4. It was overwhelming to receive positive response by 70 percent students for availability of online resources and library digital resources and reading material support.
5. Around 65 Percent of the students rated in between 3 and 4 for the facilities available in the Institute such as installation of LCDs, Desktops, seating area, etc.

Actions Taken

2. With an Aim to provide practical exposure different Workshops on the important topics was organized by the Institute.
