




<u>Question 1:</u> Do you agree that the curriculum has sufficient balance between theoretical and practical knowledge?



<u>Question 2:</u> Do you agree that the syllabus provides adequate knowledge of the fundamental concepts?





<u>Question 4:</u> Do you agree that the teachers provide the students opportunities to learn and grow?




<u>Question 5:</u> How satisfied are you with the Teaching methodology and tools adopted by teachers for effective learning?





<u>Question 7:</u> Are you satisfied with the course and reference material available in the college library?




<u>Question 8:</u> Were you given enough opportunities and encouragement to participate in extracurricular and co-curricular activities?






Question 1: How satisfied are you with the syllabus prescribed by the University?

<u>Question 2:</u> How satisfied are you with the infrastructure and facilities provided to you by the college?







<u>Question 7:</u> Are you satisfied with the practical training, seminars, workshops, and other activities organized by the college for the students?







OVERALL OBSERVATIONS





Question 1: Learning experience in terms of relevance to real life application?





Question 3: How helpful were the teachings of college in your professional life?





<u>Question 4:</u> Development activities and programs organized by the college for your overall development?





Question 5: Skills/ competencies developed during course of your study.










Question 8: Integration of theory and practical in class.








<u>Question 1</u>: How satisfied are you with the Relevant knowledge and skills of the students.



<u>Question 2:</u> How would you rate Creative and innovation in response to workplace challenges?





<u>Question 3:</u> Rate the Relationship of the student/s with seniors/peers/subordinates?


Question 4: Are they ethical, Self-motivated, and taking appropriate level of






Question 1: How satisfied are you with the admission procedure by the Institution/ University?




<u>Question 3:</u> How would you rate the administrative authorities, are they easily approachable. regarding any queries?



Question 4: Are you satisfied with the subject faculties?




Question 5: Are you satisfied with the updates communicated by the institution?




